WHAT: A WADT's Domestic Violence Court Advocate provides assistance to those seeking services at various courts across Georgia.

Services include:

**Assistance with protective orders and filing protective orders Court
Accompaniments for protective order hearings and some family court hearings
Assistance with service of protective orders as needed Victims Rights information**

**Provide safety planning and community resources and referrals as appropriate
Provide basic information on family court procedures Referral to legal assistance
and advocacy**

The court advocates at all sites are bilingual in Spanish and English and can assist individuals in person or over the phone.

WHO: Anyone who is a victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking in need of assistance
